JAKIM AWARDS AJINOMOTO COMPANY “THE BEST MALAYSIAN HALAL CERTIFICATE HOLDER”

It was a notable achievement for Ajinomoto (Malaysia) Berhad (AMB) to receive “The Best Malaysian Halal Certificate Holder” Award under the Large Industry Category by the Department of Islamic Development Malaysia (JAKIM), during the National Halal Conference 2021. The confer-

ence was launched by the Malaysian Prime Minister, Datuk Seri Ismail Sabri Yaakob.
